On a quiet tree-lined street amongst other handsome bungalows in the Fernside neighborhood of Alameda, you'll find this very special home.

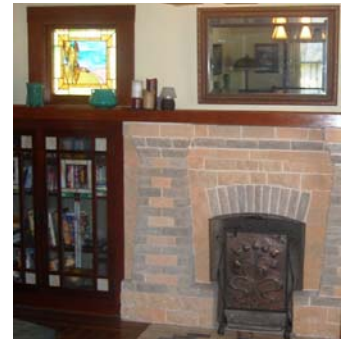
